John McCain

Ann Kirkpatrick

Abortion on Demand

John McCain is pro-life. He opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children.

Ann Kirkpatrick supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

John McCain co-sponsored and voted to advance the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act* (H.R. 36).

Ann Kirkpatrick voted against the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act* (H.R. 36).

John McCain supports the *Dismemberment Abortion Ban Act*, a bill to ban a common and brutal method of abortion in which the living unborn child is torn apart limb from limb.

Ann Kirkpatrick is a co-sponsor of H.R. 448, a bill that, if enacted, would invalidate nearly all state and federal limitations on abortion.

Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

John McCain is a co-sponsor of the *No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act* (S. 582), a bill that would enact a permanent, government-wide prohibition of taxpayer funding for abortion.

Ann Kirkpatrick voted to allow the use of tax dollars to pay for abortion (H.R. 7) (Roll Call No. 45, 1/22/15).

Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act

John McCain is a co-sponsor of the *Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act*, a bill to protect babies who are born alive during abortions.

Ann Kirkpatrick voted against passage of the *Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act* (Roll Call No. 506, 9/18/2015).

Government Funding for Abortion Providers

John McCain voted for passage of a budget reconciliation bill (H.R. 3762) that would defund Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion provider.

Ann Kirkpatrick voted against passage of a budget reconciliation bill (H.R. 3762) that would defund Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion provider.

Obamacare Health Care Law

John McCain voted against the Obamacare law. He is committed to reversing the abortion-expanding and rationing effects of that law.

Ann Kirkpatrick voted for Obamacare, which provides government funding for insurance plans that pay for abortion on demand, and imposes rationing of lifesaving medical care.
