Abortion on Demand

Kathy Szeliga is pro-life. She opposes abortion on demand, and supports protection for unborn children.

Chris Van Hollen supports a policy of abortion on demand, which allows abortion for any reason.

Kathy Szeliga supports the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act*, legislation to protect unborn children who can feel pain by prohibiting abortion at 20 weeks, a point by which the unborn child is capable of experiencing great pain when being killed by dismemberment or other late abortion methods.

Chris Van Hollen voted against the *Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act* (H.R. 36).

Chris Van Hollen is a co-sponsor of H.R. 448, a bill that, if enacted, would invalidate nearly all state and federal limitations on abortion.

Taxpayer Funding for Abortion

Kathy Szeliga opposes the use of tax dollars for abortion.

Chris Van Hollen voted to allow the use of tax dollars to pay for abortion (H.R. 7) (Roll Call No. 45, 1/22/15).

Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act

Kathy Szeliga supports a bill that would require care be given to babies who survive abortion.

Chris Van Hollen voted against passage of the *Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act* (Roll Call No. 506, 9/18/2015).

Government Funding for Abortion Providers

Kathy Szeliga opposes providing government funds to abortion providers.

Chris Van Hollen voted to provide government funds to the nation's largest abortion provider.

Obamacare Health Care Law

Kathy Szeliga opposes the Obamacare law. She is committed to reversing the abortion-expanding and rationing effects of that law.

Chris Van Hollen supports Obamacare, which provides government funding for insurance plans that pay for abortion on demand, and will lead to the rationing of lifesaving medical treatments.
